

SUMMARY OF MINUTES
CALHOUN COUNTY COMMISSION
JUNE 10, 2021

Chairman Hess called to order the regular meeting of the Calhoun County Commission and all Commissioners were present. County Engineer Brian Rosenbalm gave an invocation and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Commissioners approved the payment of warrants issued, to-wit:

Dr. David West, County Extension Coordinator, recognized Shaquila Burks, Owner/Director of A Vision for Kids Daycare Center, for completing Breast Feeding Friendly Childcare Certification. Dr. West presented Ms. Burks with a certificate of recognition on behalf of the Alabama Partnership for Children (APC), Alabama Department of Public Health and Alabama Breastfeeding Committee.

Chairman Hess introduced Sherry Brown and her daughter Gemma, and presented a check from the County Commission to the McClellan Chapter of the Back Country Horsemen of American to support “Sassy Tails,” a special needs program for children.

Commissioner Henderson made a motion to adopt the agenda, followed by a second to the motion from Commissioner Wilson. All Commissioners voted in favor of the motion.

A motion was made by Commissioner Henderson and seconded by Commissioner Patterson to adopt the minutes of the previous meeting. The motion carried with a unanimous vote of the Commissioners.

Environmental Enforcement Manager Reggie Stewart recommended proceeding with the nuisance abatements on the following properties owned by Clifton R. & Annie Ruth Dill: (1) 105 Wayside Drive, Anniston; and (2) 107 Wayside Drive, Anniston. The owners were notified of the meeting but were not present. Commissioner Henderson made a motion to proceed, Commissioner Wilson seconded the motion, and all Commissioners voted in favor of the motion. (RESOLUTIONS IN FILE)

County Administrator Mark Tyner presented an ABC Board application for a 050 – Retail Beer and 070 – Retail Table Wine license, off premises only, submitted by Bryant Feed and Seed LLC, dba Bryant Feed and Seed, 12334 US Highway 431, Ohatchee. This was the first reading of this application so no further action was required at this time.

Commissioner Henderson made a motion to adjourn, followed by a second to the motion from Commissioner Patterson. All Commissioners voted in favor of the motion.
